You are about to enter into a product that is not simple and may be difficult to understand.

What is this product?

Type

This product is an over the counter (OTC) contract – Interest Rate Instrument

Term

The maturity of this product is in 10 years. The client is entitled to terminate it unilaterally.

Objectives

The purpose of this product is to hedge an underlying interest rate exposure by periodically exchanging floating for fixed interest rate payments from the start date until the end date. The investor has the right but not the obligation to exit the Cancellable Swap at one or more pre-determined dates. The fixed rate will typically be higher than a similar interest rate swap without cancellation rights.

The product involves the following cash flows:

This product exchanges floating interest payments for fixed interest payments for an agreed period of time. The fixed rate payer will each period pay the fixed rate and receive the floating rate, where the cash flows are netted such that there is only one net cash flow for each interest rate period. The investor can cancel the product at no cost on one or more pre-specified dates.

Intended retail investor

The product is intended for retail investors who:

- intend to hold the product for the recommended investment horizon (throughout the term/until maturity)

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

Risk indicator



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product until the agreed maturity date. You may not be able to end your product early. You may have to pay significant extra costs to end your product early.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as 7 out of 7, which is the highest risk class. We classify all OTC derivatives as being of the highest risk class. This rates the potential losses from future performance at a very high level, and poor market conditions are very unlikely to impact the capacity of DNB Bank ASA to pay you. In some circumstances you may be required to make further payments to pay for losses. The total loss you may incur may be significant. This product does not include any protection from future market performance so you could incur significant losses. If we are not able to pay you what is owed, you could incur significant losses.

Recommended Holding Period: 10 years
